
In accordance with the provisions of the New Jersey Anti-Bully Bill of Rights Act and the Boonton Board of Education Policy #5512.01, parents or guardians who are not in agreement with the outcome of a HIB investigation may request and receive a hearing before the Board of Education.

In an email I received on March 26, 2019 you requested an appeal before the Board of Education regarding the investigative outcome of a HIB incident that occurred on February 6, 2019 involving your son, J [REDACTED]. Today, in a phone conversation with my assistant, Rose Sullivan, Mr. J [REDACTED] consented to meet for the appeal hearing with the Board on April 8, 2019.

The hearing will take place with the Board of Education in closed session on Monday, April 8, 2019, at 8:30 PM or later, in the Board Annex at 434 Lathrop Avenue. The HIB incident, as it pertains to your son, J [REDACTED] will be reviewed at this time.
