Student Interviews:

spoke with school counselor, at the end of the school day on February 6th. She was upset about an incident that took place earlier in the morning, prior to the start of school and said, "This school is racist, I don't want to come here." She shared that she heard a student say the "n word" to some other students and she was upset about it. did not know the student's name and agreed to come to the next morning to look at student photos in order to identify the student who made the comment.

Swas interviewed on February 7th by Christine Maier, ABS, and Peter Nosal, principal. She reported that on February 6th, she was waiting to enter school and talking with peers.

She reports that some boys nearby were talking and laughing about a comment one of the boys made about another's boy's shorts and leggings. She said she then heard one of the boys refer to another student using the "n word". Swadd did not hear the comments made by other students in the conversation, but once she heard that word, she gave that student "a look" then turned to her friend, and expressed her disbelief about hearing that word used.

was interviewed on February 7th by Christine Maier, ABS, and Peter Nosal, principal. When asked to recount the conversations she'd had the morning of February 6th prior to the start of school, she denied hearing any offensive language. She did state that her friend, turned to her at one point upset and asked her, "Did you hear that?" regarding an offensive remark that was made by a student nearby.

was interviewed on February 7th by Christine Maier, ABS, and Peter Nosal, principal regarding the conversation he was having with peers before school yesterday. stated that a student next to him made a comment asking why he was wearing jean shorts and joked that, "white people call them jorts". was asked if anything else was said that would be offensive and he said he did not remember. When asked specifically if the "n word" was used, he asked, "Like the hard ge-r way or the g-g-a way?" He proceeded to share that the first pronunciation is considered offensive, and the second one is not. He denied that anything offensive was said to him on Wednesday morning and indicated when asked, that acknowledging anything was said would be considered "snitching". He said many students use the "g-g-a" pronunciation.

was interviewed on February 7th by Christine Maier, ABS, and Peter Nosal, principal. He was asked about the conversation he was involved in the morning of February 6th prior to the start of school. He stated he did not hear anything offensive said by anyone.

was interviewed on February 7th by Christine Maier, ABS, and Peter Nosal, principal and asked if she heard any offensive language used the morning of February 6th prior to the start of school. She said she was talking with and did not hear anything offensive.

James and Peter Nosal, principal, as he was absent on February 7th. James arrived to the interview agitated and asked, "What did I do?" When asked what he was talking about with other students before entering school on Wednesday, February 6th, James asked if he made any comments that were inappropriate or offensive, he said he did not. He was reminded of the students he was talking with, as he was absent on February 7th and this interview was on the 8th. James asked if he said the "n word" at any time in that conversation, at which point he exclaimed, "I am not getting a HIB for that! I wasn't saying it to anyone. I only use that word with my friends who aren't offended by it and say it too, in private conversations". He went on to say,

"If I go to class today, I could hear that word used 30 times by a lot of people. It's the way people talk. If someone is eavesdropping on my conversations and they are offended, that's their problem." Journal proceeded to say that he wouldn't say those things or curse for example, in front of "little kids". He was informed that while he may not intentionally use offensive language in front of "little kids" or anyone else, he might not always be aware of who else may be able to hear his conversations. Journal premained angry stating, "I could name two other people who used that word in the conversation, but I'm not a snitch." Journal was reminded that all students have a right to feel comfortable coming to school and may be offended by language that is not offensive to him and his friends.

Summary and Conclusion:

This incident meets the criteria for a confirmed HIB based upon a student having the right to attend school and not be subjected to racially charged language. While Judid not use the word in a malicious manner, another student who was offended by it overheard him.

In reviewing the camera footage, it appears that something was said that caused the target to have a visible reaction, corroborating the information gathered through student interviews.
